Working Session 4:45 PM:

For the purposes of: Obtaining signatures for payment of the bills; updates from Township Administrator Grim; as well as agenda review.

General Session:

The regular meeting of the Monclova Township Board of Trustees commenced with the Pledge of Allegiance at 5:30 PM.

Roll call of trustees: Trustee Chuck Hoecherl, present; Trustee Trudy Vicary, present; Trustee Barbara Lang, present.

No changes were made to the presented agenda.

Moved by Trustee Hoecherl, seconded by Trustee Vicary, to dispense with the reading of the May 15 and Special Meeting of May 30, 2023 minutes and approve as submitted by Fiscal Officer Pike. Mr. Pike called roll: Hoecherl, yes; Vicary, yes; Lang, yes.

Moved by Trustee Lang, seconded by Trustee Vicary, to approve payment of the bills as presented by Fiscal Officer Pike totaling \$266,266.37. Mr. Pike called roll: Hoecherl, yes; Vicary, yes; Lang, yes.

Fiscal Officer's Report:

Hoecherl moved, Vicary seconded, to approve the transfer of \$1,000,000 from Signature Bank Operating account to STAR OHIO. Mr. Pike called roll: Hoecherl, yes; Vicary, yes; Lang, yes.

Old Business:

The Residential Tax Increment Financing (TIF), which is a first for Lucas County, is being proposed for land off of Stitt Road. Law Director Sanderson competing details on this.

No additional news for park improvements. Fitness rack has been installed.

Update to Admin-MTFD remodeling updates: Administrator Grim noted additional work regarding concept drawings. Interviewed additional company. Hoecherl mentioned additional option from KCS Contracting for estimated expense of wish list items.

Sanderson will be working on additional to JEDD territory.

Solar Field Moratorium: Zoning Administrator Wagner noted work with Sanderson on Zoning Resolution language. Hoecherl inquired on timeline. Wagner believed draft would be available in the next few weeks. Lang commented on effect of moratorium on Dana on Briarfield Boulevard. Suggested a partnership with Dana on making sure the language is the best that it can be. Conversation with trustees and Wagner on awareness that Dana was discussing a solar field. Hoecherl commented on large parcel transfer that was the push towards the moratorium resolution while zoning resolution amendment was written and placed through various public hearings.

Jeff Cole, with Dana, spoke of landlocked 10 acre parcel off of Technology Drive, south and adjacent of headquarter. Dana would never expand in the direction; it is dedicated to their solar field project. Started conversation in March of 2022 with Zoning Office. Worked closely with Wagner to alleviate any concerns. Working with First Energy to create opportunity. April, 2023 was last correspondence. This past Friday was emailed notification of moratorium. Key project that will provide nearly all of the energy that facility will need. This is part of Dana's sustainability objectives, reducing carbon footprint.

Jason Slattery, with Gem Energy, stated that they are a week away from submitting to Monclova's Zoning Office. Customary to grant special use permit (conditional use), initial dialogue was understanding rules. Design-wise, will be aesthetically pleasing. Working with utility to accept inter-connection. Concerned about timing. After discussion amongst the trustees, Lang moved to rescind 05152023-02, seconded by Vicary. Mr. Pike called roll: Hoecherl, yes; Vicary, yes; Lang, yes.

New Business:

Fire Department equipment: Assistant Chief noted some equipment being proposed for replacement are not owned by the township; owned by the Firefighters' Association. Conversation regarding purchasing now versus waiting for construction contractor. Hoecherl stated (6:31 PM) questions he had regarding electrical, fitting, etc. Homik commented on ceiling fan versus the floor fan that is noted in the meeting packet.

Vicary moved to approve up to \$20,000 for the attached equipment and remodeling expenses for fire department kitchen update and certain items that need to be located in the fire department. Discussion. Motion died due to lack of second. Lang voiced concerned regarding flexibility and hierarchy.

Lang moved to approve up to \$20,000 to make improvements to the fire department as approved by Administrator Grim. Seconded by Hoecherl. Mr. Pike called roll: Hoecherl, yes; Vicary, yes; Lang, yes.

Township Administrator's Report:

Grim gave information regarding refuse/recycling user charge. New annual rate is \$112.32 Lang moved, Hoecherl seconded, to request the Lucas County Commissioners as Board of Directors of the Lucas County Solid Waste Management district to establish the user charge for residential refuse collection and recycling services in Monclova Township at \$ 112.32 annually for five years and to proceed with certification of charges placement on the tax duplicates to the residential properties served thereto. Mr. Pike called roll: Hoecherl, yes; Vicary, yes; Lang, yes.

Hoecherl moved, Vicary seconded, to Approve Resolution 06052023-01, Approving a Joint Cooperation Agreement for the Monclova Road at Waterville-Monclova Road roundabout project between the Board of Monclova Township and Lucas County Mr. Pike called roll: Hoecherl, yes; Vicary, yes; Lang, yes.

Hoecherl noted 21 applications for Fire Chief and committee is meeting next week to start screening process.
