

POLICY OF THE MONCLOVA TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
REGARDING MAILBOXES DAMAGED AS A RESULT OF SNOW REMOVAL
ACTIVITIES ON TOWNSHIP STREETS AND ROADS

ADOPTED JANUARY 21, 2014

REVISED MARCH 16, 2015

If a mailbox is damaged by the blade of a Township snow plow and it cannot be repaired by the Township it will be replaced with a simple galvanized or aluminum mailbox on a metal post at Township expense. Owners eligible for a replacement mailbox may choose instead to be reimbursed up to \$125.00 by providing necessary documentation of replacement with a mailbox of their own choosing. If a mailbox is damaged in any other way, the Township will make every effort to erect the damaged mailbox so the owner can continue to receive mail, but any expenses to repair/replace the damaged mailbox will be the responsibility of the owner.
