CURRENT CONTRACT WITH REPUBLIC SERVICES:

•Normal household waste only (no construction or remodeling debris) every-other-week on a North/South Route schedule; dividing line is Monclova Road.

Monclova Road addresses are South Route.

•Apartment buildings are not covered under the township's services.

•One toter limit on township collection day.

•Trash must be out by 7:00 AM.

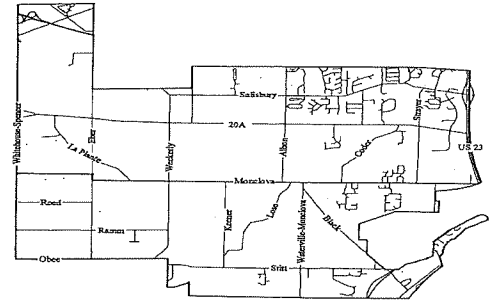
•Large item collection: Asterisk (*) At least 48-hour advance notice must be given. N

•No item will be accepted that will harm a sanitation worker or a truck, i.e. pool S

chemicals, gasoline, steel pipe, excessive weight of container.

•No loose garbage in your toter.

MISSED? The truck will not come back if you did not place your garbage out by 7 AM.



Township trash collection service will be changing soon.

- Changes are necessary because no trash providers would bid on the current level of service.
- Stevens Disposal will be the new trash collection company.
- Once the Stevens contract is in place, Republic Services will no longer provide trash collection in the township. If you subscribe to any of their services you may need to request a refund from them – call 1-800-234-3429.
- The new service will include weekly trash collection and every other week curbside recycling.
- The schedule will change but details have not been finalized.*
- The schedule for the transition has not been determined.*
- *Updates will be posted on www.monclovatwp.org and communicated via email through Monclova Alerts.
- Once determined, final trash collection details will be included in a future mailer from the township.
- 96 gallon toters that will be provided by Stevens for refuse collection are optional but will be required for recycling.
- Refuse collection will be limited to three 33 gallon cans, three 33 gallon bags, or one 96 gallon toter.
- If you choose not to use a toter or want a smaller container, you will need to purchase your own 33 gallon cans or containers.
- Large item pickup service will still be available.
- The Township will cover 40% of the cost, the remaining 60% will be applied to your property taxes as a user charge at a rate of \$98.88 annually (\$49.44 per half) once finalized by the Lucas County Commissioners.
- This service could cost as much as \$25.00 per month if contracted privately.

Fall Leaf Collection

Township curbside leaf pickup service for public roadways is a no-fee service beginning mid-October with a flexible ending as winter weather is eminent. Rake as soon as you can so you are prepared when we stop collecting.

- It is **NOT** necessary to call the township regarding the collection of your leaves. Crews continuously monitor the public roadways. This process may take up to two weeks.

- Piles should be **as close to the edge of the road as possible** without going in the road.

- We will **NOT** collect piles that contain non-leaf debris or bagged leaves.

Seasonal disposal is available locally at:

- Township-provided free drop-off at Ohio Compost, 10839 Sager Road (Maumee-Western west towards the Airport changes to "Sager Road"). Call 419-897-7807 for hours of operation or go to ohiocompost.com.
