Shredded paper should be placed in a paper bag first to prevent fly-away debris. </div>	

DROP-OFF RECYCLING STATIONS

Drop off locations for recycling are provided by Lucas County Solid Waste Management at nearby locations:

- Kroger, Waterville
 - Springfield Township Fire Station #3, Holloway Rd. near Garden Road
 - The former Anderson's General Store location on Illinois Avenue
 - Village of Whitehouse recycling station, 11295 Waterville Street
- Accepted: Plastics 1 & 2 ONLY; Glass; Aluminum; Newspapers; Magazines; Phone Books; Cardboard; and Corrugated Boxes.
- Remember to empty, clean, and dry - this is truly the proper method of having your containers evolve into recyclables. If food residue or liquids are left, they generally end up in the landfill.
