<i>Maclura pomifera</i>	Osage-Orange
<i>Platanus occidentalis</i>	Sycamore
<i>Populus deltoides</i>	Eastern Cottonwood
<i>Quercus bicolor</i>	Swamp White Oak
<i>Quercus macrocarpa</i>	Bur Oak
<i>Quercus muehlenbergii</i>	Chinkapin Oak
<i>Quercus palustris</i>	Pin Oak
<i>Quercus rubra</i>	Red Oak
<i>Quercus shumardii</i>	Shumard Oak
