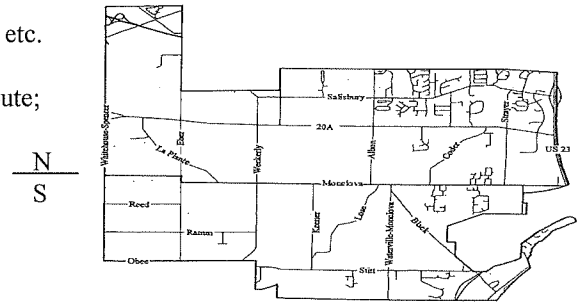

TRASH SERVICE COVERED UNDER THE CONTRACT WITH REPUBLIC SERVICES:

- Normal household waste collection every-other-week on a North/South Route schedule; dividing line is Monclova Road (see map). Monclova Road addresses are South Route.
- Apartment buildings are not covered under the township's services.
- Township trash limits apply. Toter limit refers to the specific toter you received from Republic Services. 95, 65, & 38 gallon options available through Republic Services, 1-734-848-5226 or 1-800-234-3429.
- Trash must be out by 7:00 AM. Changes in weather conditions, crew assignment, etc. can cause your pickup to be earlier or later in the day.
- Large item collection: Asterisk (*) on calendar indicates collection date for your route; see below for restrictions. At least 48-hour advance notice must be given.
- No construction or remodeling debris.
- No item will be accepted that will harm a sanitation worker or a truck, i.e. pool chemicals, gasoline, steel pipe, excessive weight of container.
- No loose garbage in your toter.



MISSED? The truck will not come back if you did not place your garbage out by 7 AM.

LIMIT ON TRASH: One (1) Republic Services Toter. Limit refers to the specific toter you received from Republic Services, i.e. your 95 gallon toter is your limit; your neighbor ordered the 65 gallon toter-that is their limit. No bags above toter line or on the side of your toter. You may increase your level of service through Republic Services or a vendor of your choice if you cannot adhere to limit. Consider waste reduction through recycling options (drop off sites or curbside through Republic Services) and yard waste disposal sites.

DEFINITIONS:

LARGE ITEM: Examples-Stove, refrigerator with technician verification that Freon has been removed, washing machine, chair.

YARD WASTE: Containerized (regular garbage bags) yard waste (grass clippings, brush, etc.) is accepted but township limit must be adhered to. Fee-free drop off seasonal program is available through Ohio Compost, 10839 Sager Rd., Monclova Township, 419-897-7807, ohiocompost.com.

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS (not allowed) Building material resulting from remodeling, repair, demo operations or new construction



Reminders:

- Please remember appropriate items for recycling! Neither Republic Services curbside or Lucas County drop-off sites accept plastic bags or styrofoam.
- The metal bar on your toter should be facing the street.
